10 **Call to Order:** Chris Roberts called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. As the meeting lacked a
11 quorum, the minutes from September or October could not be approved, and the annual election
12 of officers could not be held, since the Committee could not take any action.

14 **Public Works Report:** Doug Draper reported on current activities in the Park, such as the status
15 of the horseshoe pits renovation, a tree removal/trimming contract, plantings, cleanups, and that
16 beavers have returned. He also said that the Winter Wonderland of Lights would be turned on
17 November 29. Mike Moulds said that the City now has two certified playground employees for
18 safety surveys and that the City has joined the Maryland Recreation and Parks Association.

20 **Master Plan:** The Committee discussed the Master Plan process. It was determined that Gary
21 Makes, the County Parks & Recreation Director would be invited to the January meeting for his
22 input. There was also consensus that the Committee would choose a survey method in January
23 for public input for the plan.

25 **Other Items:** Chris Roberts received a letter from the Salisbury Chess Club, which he read to
26 the Committee, asking for consideration of chess benches in the park.
