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11 **Call to Order:** David Plotts called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m.

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13 **Minutes:** David Plotts distributed minutes from March and meeting notes from April. A motion  
14 was made by Dr. Amal Ali, seconded, by Chris Roberts, and carried to approve the minutes.  
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16 **Public Works Report:** Mike Moulds, New tennis courts lights have been installed. Bens Red  
17 Swings is begging work on a permanent bathroom facility and once finished the city will  
18 maintain, the building and facilities. The corn hole/horseshoe pits are still under construction and  
19 should be finished by this summer. The city is looking into putting new lights at Picnic Island as  
20 well as the new horseshoe pits.  
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22 **Splash Park Proposal:** David updated the Committee on the presentation to Council on May  
23 18. Council liked the idea of a splash park, and would like the splash park group to perform  
24 further study on a location. They requested pros/cons of the locations and feedback from a  
25 public meeting before committing to a site.  
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27 **Master Plan:** Mike Moulds handed out the latest proposals for the new company's applying for  
28 the job of putting the master plan together. We are now looking into an hourly rate with the  
29 hopes that we can hire out certain jobs and do others with in our own ability to save on cost.  
30 David Plotts and David Herrick have been given copies of the proposals to review and rate and  
31 bring back there opinion to Mike and the committee.  
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33 **Other Business:** Park user survey, the committee came up with the idea to do a park user survey  
34 to use as part of the master plan to get a better understanding of who and how the park is getting  
35 used, as a committee we would like to come up with a set of questions to hand out and use  
36 during the survey. New bylaws for the donation policy might need to be written and the previous  
37 bylaws may need to be rewritten, as part of the new master plan.
