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10 **Call to Order:** Chris Roberts called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m. As the meeting lacked a  
11 quorum, the minutes from September, October, or November could not be approved, and the  
12 annual election of officers could not be held, since the Committee could not take any action.

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14 **Public Works Report:** Doug Draper reported on current activities in the Park, such as the status  
15 tree & bush plantings, beaver damaged trees, and cleaning up the mountain bike trails. The Dog  
16 Park was also discussed as there are depressions at the entry gate that hold water, and there is  
17 interest in lighting the Dog Park with the old tennis court lights. Mike Moulds said that the Boy  
18 Scouts are continuing to work on the horseshoe pits and Public Works is still looking for a  
19 source for new wheels for the cannon by the bandstand. Mike Moulds also mentioned the Ben's  
20 Red Swings bathroom project, to which Matt Drew was able to provide an update on.

22 **Mountain Bike Trails:** Mike Perry from ESIMBA shows pictures of proposed kiosks that they  
23 would like to install at the trail heads, they are comprised of wood and built themselves. There  
24 was also a discussion on trail markings, painting the trees vs. other marking schemes of PVC or  
25 Carsonite. Chris Roberts asked that ESIMBA make a formal recommendation to the Park  
26 Committee, for its review. Alex McRae discussed a trail cleanup by Bike SBY and ESIMBA on  
27 MLK day, January 19, 2015

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29 **Master Plan:** Mike Moulds updated the Committee. He plans on breaking down the plan into  
30 two phases, which could be split between Fiscal Years to allow for the use of \$20,000 this year  
31 and a proposed \$20,000 next year. He said that the city surveyor has GPS equipment and will  
32 begin surveying the park and its buildings, paths, and equipment.
