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10 **Call to Order:** Chris Roberts called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

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12 **Minutes:** David Plotts distributed minutes from September and meeting notes from October,
13 November, and January. A motion was made by Tim Spies, seconded, by DJ Lumpkin, and
14 carried to approve the minutes.

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16 **Public Works Report:** Doug Draper reported on current activities in the Park, such as sledding,
17 snow clean up, and removal of downed limbs and trees.

19 **Election of Officers:** Chris Roberts began elections for a Chairman, Vice Chairman, and
20 Secretary.

21 Chairman: A motion was made by DJ Lumpkin to nominate David Plotts as Chairman.
22 There were no other nominations. The motion was seconded by Mike Perry, and the vote
23 carried to elect David Plotts as Chairman.

25 Chris Roberts turned the meeting over to David as the new Chairman.

27 Vice Chairman: A motion was made by DJ Lumpkin to nominate Chris Roberts as Vice
28 Chairman. There were no other nominations. The motion was seconded by David Plotts,
29 and carried to appoint Chris Roberts as Vice Chairman.

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31 Secretary: A motion was made by Chris Roberts to nominate DJ Lumpkin as Secretary.
32 There were no other nominations. The motion was seconded by Amal Ali, and carried to
33 appoint DJ Lumpkin as Secretary.

35 **Splash Park Proposal:** David Plotts introduced Joe Ollenger and Mike Wessels who presented
36 the idea of a splash park in the City Park. After the presentation the Committee questioned Joe
37 and Mike about various aspects of the proposal. The Committee thanked Joe and Mike for the

38 presentation, and they were excused. David asked the Committee to research the proposal for
39 discussion at the March meeting.

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41 **Committee Charter:** David Plotts passed out the latest version of the revised committee
42 charter/resolution. He asked that the Committee read it over, for action at the March meeting.

44 **Other Business:** There was discussion about various groups who have runs or walks through the
45 park, and their painting numbers and arrows on trees. The Committee felt that flagging tape or
46 irrigation flags would be a better solution. Tim Spies said he would investigate the regulations.
