Public Works Report: The City Park is being used more now that the weather is nicer. Prep work has begun on the grounds where the skate park will be going; the city is cleaning the site and removing shrubs and invasive species. Summer concerts at the band stand will be starting soon.

Splash Park Proposal: Sites are still being discussed The mayor wants to create a round table discussion of possible sites.

Master Plan: Landscape Architectural Services LLC has won the bid to build the master plan. The budget committee has as July 1st allotted another 20 thousand dollars to help fund the master plan. The committee is currently working on the community survey section of the plan, and is reviewing options and questions to be given out to fulfill the survey needs.

Other Business: The representative from ESIMBA presented their plans and map layout for the signage for the bike trails in the park, to include the four kiosks and the trail markers. A Dam Road Task force wants to clean up the road behind the Ward Museum, which is now part of the green way; a community discussion is now scheduled to discuss plans and possible uses.
