10 **Call to Order:** David Plotts called the meeting to order at 6:05 pm.

11  
12 **Minutes:** Minutes from April 21, 2016 and May 19, 2016 were distributed. A motion was made by  
13 David Herrick, seconded by Chris Roberts, and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

15 **Public Works Report:** Doug Draper and Mike Moulds provided updates on park activities,  
16 including: new youth employment program, fishing derby, Ben's Red Swings bathroom, cameras at  
17 the skate park, and an upcoming Maryland Historical Trust meeting for the Rotary Centennial  
18 project.

19  
20 **Park & Recreational Area List:** David Plotts presented a list of City parks and recreational areas,  
21 which includes their address and amenities. A few additions were made. This list will permit the  
22 Committee to review all the parks at a later time.

23  
24 **Park Rules:** David Plotts opened a discussion on the need for park rules. Currently, the Zoo and  
25 Ben's Red Swings are covered by rules in code form, while a resolution that is unenforceable covers  
26 the other parks. As part of the Master Plan, a set of city wide park rules should be implemented.  
27 Currently, there is no city wide hours for parks. Some have signage, others don't. David researched  
28 other Maryland cities and created a starting point of rules in a code format. He asked the Committee  
29 to review a proposed draft list as "homework" and come back with any suggestions or changes at the  
30 next meeting.

31  
32 The idea banning drones or regulating them, was brought up. David Plotts said he believed there was  
33 federal or state law that would prevent the City from regulating them, but he would check.
