10 **Call to Order:** David Plotts called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

11  
12 **Minutes:** Minutes from November were presented. After review, a motion to amend the minutes  
13 was made by Chris Roberts, seconded by Mike Perry, and carried, to add to the proposed changes of  
14 the City Park Master Plan: “Moved Disc Golf to East End and expanded to 18-holes.” A motion  
15 was made by Chris Roberts seconded by Mike Perry and carried to approve the minutes as amended.

16  
17 **Public Works Report:** Doug Draper updated the Committee on activities in the past month, which  
18 include cleanup from sledding in the park, tree contractor work, and an update on removal of the  
19 beavers that are damaging the park. Mike Moulds said he has contacted Parkside CTE looking for  
20 assistance in rehabilitating the canon in the City Park. He hopes to have it rehabilitated by the 100<sup>th</sup>  
21 anniversary of the U.S. entry into World War I, April 6<sup>th</sup>, as it is a German 15cm sFH 02 heavy field  
22 howitzer cannon.

23  
24 **2018-2022 Capital Improvement Plan:** David Plotts distributed pages from the draft 2018-2022  
25 Capital Improvement plan where it involved a city park or recreational area. Mike Moulds and Muir  
26 Boda provided input on the items.

27  
28 **City Park Master Plan:** Mike Moulds is currently working on cost estimates for the Master Plan.

29  
30 **Park Rules:** David Plotts discussed park hours, a conundrum. There is a need for hours, however  
31 some parks have different needs, including recreation. The Committee discussed potentials. Mike  
32 Moulds will discuss the options with the Police Chief, as the solution needs to be enforceable.

33  
34 **Committee Goals:** David Plotts introduced draft 2017 Committee Goals. They included short term  
35 for 2017 and long term for 2017-2019. The Committee liked the idea of visiting different parks in  
36 the short term, so in the long term the Committee can evaluate the parks for strengths, weaknesses,  
37 and opportunities for improvements.
