8 **Call to Order:** David Plotts called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm at the Government Office

17 **Master Plan:** David Plotts reviewed master plan feedback from Anne Roane. The Committee
18 discussed item 31, closure of Memorial Plaza Bridge, and decided to remove it from the plan. The
19 Committee heard from members of the public on the removal of the old fence at the softball field,
20 and about the new parking lot in the plan. A motion was made by Mike Perry, seconded by Chris
21 Roberts, and carried to recommend the Master Plan to Mayor Day with removal of #31 and for
22 further review by the City on the proper sizing of the proposed parking lot.

24 **Other Business:** Chris Roberts mentioned that Austin Widdowson was interested in becoming a
25 member of the Committee. John Terrell was also mentioned. Amal mentioned it would be nice to
26 have SU students on the Committee, even as a regular guest. Amal said that she would not be
27 seeking another term on the Committee, due to work commitments. The Committee thanked her for
28 her years of service, and invited her to return anytime.

30 With no other business, a motion to adjourn was made by Chris Roberts, and seconded by Amal Ali.
