8 **Call to Order:** David Plotts called the meeting to order at 6 p.m. in Room 306 of the Government  
9 Office Building.

11 **Minutes:** David Plotts distributed copies of the October 16, 2018 minutes. The November and  
12 December meetings were canceled. A motion was made by Dr. Brante' Dashiell, seconded by Mike  
13 Perry, and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

15 **Park Update:** Doug Draper updated the committee on activities in the parks, including a trash  
16 pickup by scouts at Naylor Mill Trails, continuing tree work in the parks. Doug provided a schematic  
17 of proposed, trash, recycling, and bench locations in the City Park. The Committee provided  
18 feedback on locations to ensure wherever a recycle can is placed, there is a trash can. Doug also  
19 provided information on a future foot bridge and pollinator garden at the end of Camden St, next to  
20 the new Riverside Dr/Mill St. traffic circle.

22 The Committee discussed the need for the City to obtain a Mid-Size Excavator and Flail Mower.  
23 The equipment would ensure the waters edge and trails continue to be clean. The Committee was in  
24 consensus to recommend to the Mayor that the City obtain such equipment.

26 **2019 Officers:** David Plotts asked the Committee to elect officers for 2019. The Committee  
27 discussed and proposed the officers remain the same as 2019 (Chairman: David Plotts, Vice  
28 Chairman: Chris Roberts, and Secretary: David Herrick). A motion was made by Dr. Brante'  
29 Dashiell, seconded by Mike Perry, and carried.
